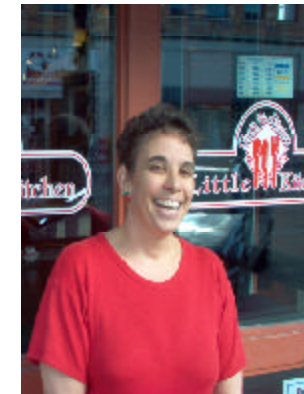

We can change that system.

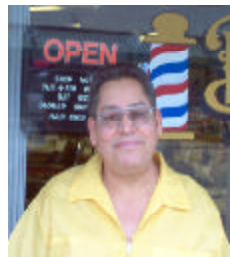
We are the Libertarian Party.
